H	Hole
F	Fillet
M	Move/copy
I	Measure
A	Appearance

Creating Custom Keyboard Shortcuts

1. Move mouse pointer to the toolbar. Select the command you want to create a custom shortcut for.
2. Move the mouse pointer to the right side of the command until you see three vertical dots.
3. Click the three dots, then select “Change keyboard shortcut”.
4. If it doesn’t already have a shortcut, assign a new shortcut key by entering one in the field.
5. Select “OK” to save your custom keyboard shortcut.
